

THINGS TO DO IN WINCHESTER

1. Jane Austen's House (25-minute drive)

Pay a visit to the house where Jane Austen wrote and published all six of her books. Now a museum, the house gives a look into Regency era life. Visitors can relive Jane Austen's daily routine and explore her objects and personal items that remain in the house.

2. 878 AD (21-minute drive)

Live through one of the most important nights in Winchester's history. Create your own shield and defend the city walls from the Vikings like a real Anglo-Saxon. Lose yourself in early medieval Winchester with footage and AR recreated by Assassin's Creed Valhalla.

3. Winchester Cathedral (25-minute drive)

Winchester Cathedral is the longest medieval cathedral in the world and is also one of the oldest in Britain. It was built in 1079. Take a look at the intricate stained-glass windows, the famous Winchester Bible, and both medieval and modern art.

4. Wolvesey Castle (20-minute drive)

Wolvesey Castle was one of the most important palaces in Norman Britain. Back in medieval times, Winchester was second only to London in terms of religious importance.

5. Westgate Museum (20-minute drive)

Beginning its life as a 12th-century city gateway, the Westgate Museum now houses exhibits about the marriage of Queen Mary and Philip II of Spain in 1554. You can also learn all about the effect the English Civil War had on Winchester.



6. Winchester Science Centre and Planetarium (20-minute drive)

Hear stories about our solar system and find out what it's like to be a real astronaut in space. You can also sit in a giant guitar and find out how sound and vibration travel, or make sounds in giant echo tubes.

7. Marwell Zoo (23-minute drive)

Want to see the biggest species of tiger? Head to Marwell Zoo to see Amur tigers, snow leopards and rhinos, plus lots of smaller animals like meerkats, birds, and reptiles. Marwell Zoo are also trying to become more sustainable with the hope that their Tropical House will be completely carbon-neutral soon.

8. ClueCapers (25-minute drive)

With three indoor rooms and two outdoor rooms around Winchester, this escape room will really get you thinking. Will you escape in time?

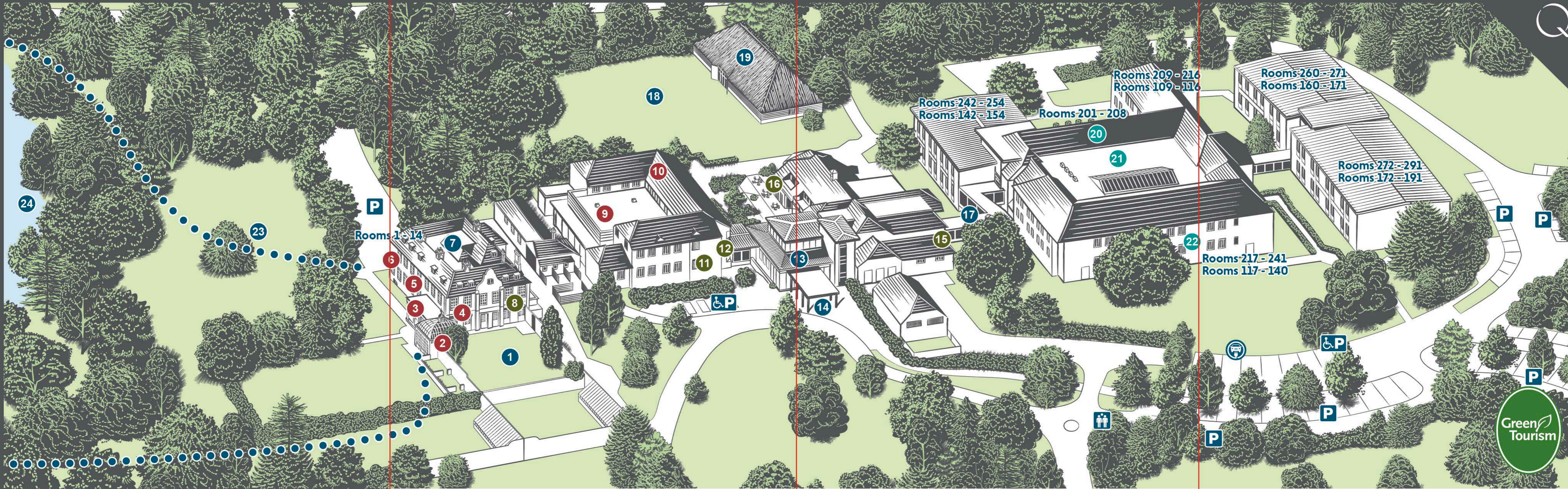
